3. All quilts must have a four inch sleeve on the top if they are to be hung in the show

5. One entry form must be completed for each entry submitted - NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

QUILTING – DIVISION 1

Q-1-1 LARGE BED QUILT - Complete quilt, top and quilting done by one person.
Any technique and any type of quilting. Perimeter greater than 310"

Q-1-2 LARGE BED QUILT - Group quilt. More than one person has worked on the quilt.
Any technique and type of quilting. Perimeter greater than 310"

Q-1-3 SMALL BED QUILT - 170" to 310"

Q -1-4 CUDDLE QUILT - Maximum Perimeter 170"

Q-1-5 TRADITIONAL WALL QUILT - based on patterns or traditional quilt blocks.

Q-1-6 ORIGINAL DESIGN REPRESENTATIONAL WALL QUILT - depicts landscapes, portraits and pictures that are realistic. Any technique.

Q-1-7 ORIGINAL DESIGN ABSTRACT WALL QUILTS - Explores shapes, textures, colour, embellishments, etc.

Q-1-8 WEARABLE - Must be quilted

Q-1-9 CHALLENGE - Theme:"Dog Days & Heritage Ways" - Max 48" square, open to any quilt technique. Entry must reflect the theme and been made in 12 months preceding the show.

Q-1-10 OTHER - Any quilted item that does not fit in the other categories.

Q-1-11 FOR DISPLAY ONLY - All quilt show items that will NOT be judged.
