- Maximum 2 entries per class per person
- Each hay sample will receive a free hay analysis
- Hay cut after a first cut of silage is considered second cut
- Classes will be judged 70% on laboratory analysis and 30% on visual appearance
- In order to be considered for these classes all bales must be clearly labeled as to owner and class entered
- Organic gardeners and farmers: Please note that no separate classes exist, however, organically grown crops may be labeled as such AFTER judging.
